REMINDERS:

PARKING: Thank you for your patience when trying to find a parking spot. Be sure to park legally to avoid receiving a ticket. A resident on Church street has asked that I remind parents not to block or partially block the driveways on the street; it makes it difficult for them to get in and out. Also, there are two classrooms and we have staggered the arrival and departure times to help with the logistics of getting 40 families in and out of the program. If your child attends a class with an 11:45 (morning) or 3:15 (afternoon) dismissal, we ask that you move your vehicle as soon as possible to make room for the next group of parents to park. We will continue to do our best to help in any way we can.
